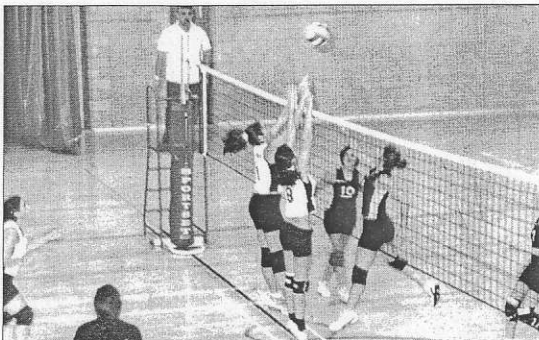

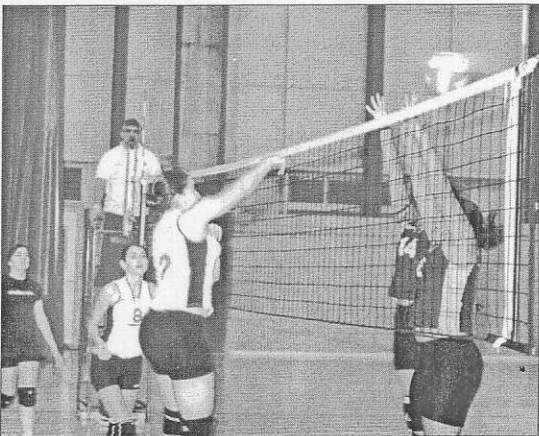
LADIES LEAGUE CUP FINAL TOMORROW

Group 4:

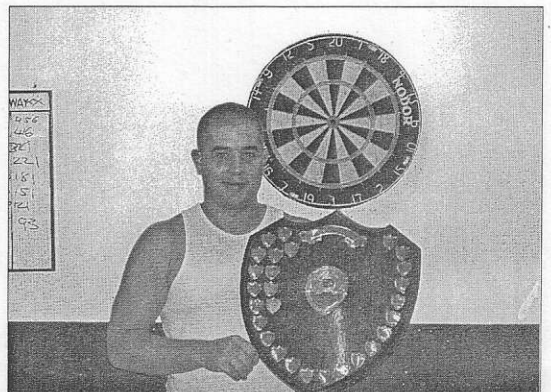
